- 15  **Petit Chablis, J. Moreau et Fils** £29.60  
*France ~ 2005/6*  
*Made in classic Chablis style, it is lean and elegant with underlying Chardonnay fruit from the northern tip of Burgundy.*
- 16  **Sancerre La Fuzelle, Adrien Maréchal** £32.95  
*France ~ 2005/6*  
*Classic Sancerre made from Sauvignon Blanc to produce a wine full of crisp, ripe acidity and gooseberry fruit.*
- 17  **Pouilly-Fuissé Les Ancolies, E. Loron et Fils** £37.90  
*France ~ 2005/6*  
*A steely, dry yet rich white Burgundy from this most prestigious of the Mâconnais vineyards. It is a Chardonnay that combines honeyed peachy richness with a citrus freshness.*

### Red Wine

- 18  **Monte Verde Cabernet Sauvignon, Central Valley** £15.30  
*Chile ~ 2008/9*  
*Vibrant and full of flavours of the ripest blackcurrant. Very soft with some oak maturation.*
- 19  **La Diva Merlot-Cabernet Sauvignon, VdP d'Oc** £17.10  
*France ~ 2005/6*  
*A Vin de Pays of real quality, elegant, full red with ripe berry fruit character and a firm tannin backbone.*
- 20  **Finca Flichman Malbec Oak-Aged, Mendoza** £17.60  
*Argentina ~ 2005/6*  
*Full-bodied and well-structured, with a typically strong, peppery nose and a slightly earthy palate.*
- 21  **Tintara Horseshoe Row Cabernet, S Australia** £18.40  
*Australia ~ 2005/6*  
*Elegant with ripe blackcurrant and blackberry fruit with subtle notes of cashew nuts on the finish.*
- 22  **Chateau Indage Tiger Hill Merlot-Shiraz, Sahyadri Valley** £18.40  
*India ~ 2006*  
*A spicy, plum-driven, silky, red from the land of the tiger.*
- 23  **Torres Mas Rabell, Penedès** £20.95  
*Spain ~ 2005/6*  
*From Garnacha Tinto and Cariñena and matured in oak for one year to give a rich fruity wine with a soft vanilla oak finish.*
- 24  **Kleine Zalze Pinotage, Stellenbosch** £18.40  
*South Africa ~ 2005/6*  
*A deep-coloured wine made from South Africa's 'own' grape variety. Excellent berry fruit flavours and soft tannins from vineyards located in the beautiful region of Stellenbosch.*
- 25  **Vidal Estate Merlot, Hawke's Bay** £28.00  
*New Zealand ~ 2004/5*  
*Fully ripe plum aromas coupled with soft, smoky oak from the barrique maturation, combine with the rich, black cherry and red berry fruit flavours and fine-grained tannins on the finish.*
- 26  **Barossa Valley Estate Shiraz, Barossa Valley** £25.75  
*Australia ~ 2003/4*  
*Sweet, smoky oak with aromatic blackcurrant fruit. Vibrant, mulberry flavours, soft long palate, fresh acidity and integrated oak sweetness.*
- 27  **Châteauneuf-du-Pape Préférence, Caves Saint-Pierre** £49.50  
*France ~ 2004/5*  
*Great richness and complexity yet smooth and rounded on the finish. An excellent sample of this famous wine from vineyards close to Avignon in the southern Rhône.*

- 28  **Vidal Estate Merlot Rosé, Hawke's Bay** £23.65  
*New Zealand ~ 2006/7*  
*Vibrant rosé colour and off-dry style, with crisp acidity and fresh lingering summer fruit aromas and flavours.*
- 29  **Vendange White Zinfandel, California** £17.80  
*USA ~ 2005/6*  
*A beautiful salmon-pink, off-dry rosé with attractive strawberry aromas and palate and fresh zingy acidity.*
- 30  **Don Jacobo Rioja Rosado, Bodegas Corral** £18.90  
*Spain ~ 2005/6*  
*A delightfully deep-coloured rosé from Spain's premier wine region, with a fresh summer fruits nose and a lively, zingy palate.*


### Organic Wine

- 31  **Bonterra Organic Viognier, North Coast** £58.30  
*USA ~ 2005/6*  
*Very creamy texture and the unmistakable and haunting aroma of dried apricot, the hallmark of classic Viognier. Barrel-fermented in 100% French oak and allowed to rest on the lees for 3 months.*
- 32  **Bonterra Organic Merlot, Mendocino County** £58.30  
*USA ~ 2002*  
*A soft, velvety wine with a complex palate of ripe, black cherry fruit, spicy-oak and cedarwood flavours blended with sweet-vanilla on the finish.*

### Low Alcohol Wine

- 33  **Sutter Home Fre Alcohol Removed Chardonnay, California** £13.00  
*USA ~ 2008*  
*Fruity and sweet with citrus and apple flavours.*

### Sparkling

- 34  **Prosecco Extra Dry, Fantinel** £26.80  
*Italy ~ NV*  
*Fresh, dry and fruity. A pleasant and extremely elegant bouquet with delightful, floral-based hints. A smooth, velvety and poetic flavour.*

### Champagne

- 35  **Bouché Père et Fils Cuvée Réservee Brut** £36.25  
*NV*  
*Light and well-balanced with good maturity and a biscuity flavour, blended from Chardonnay, Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier.*
- 36  **Piper-Heidsieck Brut** £41.50  
*NV*  
*Young, lively fruit flavours and a fresh, vivid aroma characterise this attractive Champagne.*
- 37  **Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial** £48.40  
*NV*  
*A consistent, dry style with a distinctive flowery aroma. Yeasty character, a long, biscuity flavour and good level of acidity.*
- 38  **Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label Brut** £115.50  
*NV*  
*Reflecting the traditions of the past, this is full, yet dry and has a rich, creamy style with biscuity flavours.*
- 39  **Veuve Clicquot Brut Rosé** £147.00  
*NV*  
*Luminous, fresh, pink with initial aromas of red fruits leading to dried fruits and biscuit notes.*

*1999*  
*Complex, luxury Grand Cru Champagne only made in the best years. Long and satisfying on the palate with layers of yeasty, nutty flavours.*
